



AUCTION RULES

Both members and the public are welcome!

We will accept Visa & Mastercard, check or cash

BID NUMBERS – To participate in the auction you must have a bid number. Bid numbers are \$5 each. Registration for bid numbers begins at 10 AM.

BIDDING – Bidding for koi will begin at 11AM. We will have a professional auctioneer calling the progressive bidding.

WE ASK THAT YOU BE PATIENT WHEN YOU ARE CHECKING OUT AFTER BIDDING ENDS. IT DOES TAKE TIME TO GET THE WINNING BIDS ENTERED INTO THE COMPUTER.

The RMKC-purchased koi will auction first, followed by the member-owned koi. The member-owned koi will auction by tank in an order determined by a drawing. Koi not auctioned will remain the property & responsibility of the owner. The owner cannot set a minimum bid. This minimum bid will be determined by the auction committee.

It is suggested that the proceeds from the member-owned koi sales be split 50/50 or more with RMKC.

The RMKC-purchased koi will auction first, followed by the member-owned koi. The member-owned koi will auction by tank in an order determined by a drawing. Koi not auctioned will remain the property & responsibility of the owner. The owner cannot set a minimum bid. This minimum bid will be determined by the auction committee.

RMKC has the option to group smaller fish into lots to be auctioned off as a group of fish.

Koi brought to the auction must be healthy. RMKC holds no responsibility for the health & well-being of any koi to be auctioned. Member-owned koi of questionable circumstance will be refused entry into the auction.
